The Rape and Sexual Abuse Support Centre (Rape Crisis South London) is looking for a therapist with experience of working therapeutically with acute high risk presentations to join our Children and Young People's Counselling Service as a Well-being and Safeguarding Counsellor. Working alongside play therapists, family prevention practitioners and school well-being counsellors, you will provide specialist therapy to girls and young women aged 5+ in hubs across the South London Boroughs. If you feel passionate about providing high quality, trauma-informed therapy to survivors of sexual violence and have experience of counselling young people, then this is the role for you.

We will provide the successful candidates with:

- Clinical supervision
- A salary of £36,000 - £38,000, dependent on experience, pro rata
- An in-depth induction training programme which includes the different types of sexual violence, impacts and coping strategies and the RASASC empowerment model
- Regular CPD and developmental opportunities
- Annual leave entitlement is 27 days a year plus 8 bank holidays (pro rata) plus the period of 25 December -1 January.
- NEST pension scheme; 3% employer contribution and 5% employee contribution.
